

# IV ARMENIAN ONCOLOGY CONGRESS

February 2-5, 2024

Jermuk, Armenia

World Cancer Day is a global healthcare event for the awareness of cancer, which commemorates on February 4th every year. On this occasion the National Oncology Center named after V.A.Fanarjian organizes the annual scientific event the **IV Armenian oncology congress** «Oncology in Armenia: current achievements and new challenges» which will be held on **February 2-5, 2024**, in one of the most picturesque places of Armenia - in the city of **Jermuk**.

There will be about 50 reports and more than 200 representatives of the Ministry of Health of Armenia, the National Institute of Health and the Yerevan State Medical University, oncologists of various specialties, public health experts and others will attend the event. The list of speakers includes oncologists from Armenia, Russia, the United States, Europe and Iran. The languages of the congress are Armenian, Russian and English. The congress is submitted for CME accreditation.

If you are interested to be a speaker on the congress with the presentation no more than 13-15 minutes you should send an application for participation in the scientific competition. Please send your full name, scientific degree, institution, the topic of the speech in three languages and a CV to [nco.congress@gmail.com](mailto:nco.congress@gmail.com) no later than December 15, 2023. All applications will be considered by the academic board of the organizational committee. The results of the competition will be announced on December 22, 2023.

There is a registration fee regardless of the type of participation (speaker or delegate):

1. 60.000 AMD – early registration before December 22, 2023
2. 80.000 AMD – late registration before January 19, 2024

The registration fee for clinical residents specializing in oncology is 40.000 AMD in case of early registration.

The registration fee includes participation in the congress, hotel accommodation (for one person in a double room), transfers Yerevan-Jermuk-Yerevan.
